<u>Awarded Multiple Sorts</u>. If an individual PURCHASER is awarded multiple sorts, COUNTY may contact PURCHASER to discuss mixing sorts. Sorts will not be mixed without the written consent of PURCHASER and PURCHASER's ability to pay based on the individual sorts.

- <u>Cost of Scaling</u>. All costs of scaling and all costs in connection with reports furnished to COUNTY shall be paid by PURCHASER.
- <u>Timber Harvest Tax</u>. PURCHASER shall be responsible for paying all applicable timber harvest or severance taxes and shall indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY against any tax claims arising from the purchase of County logs.
- Indemnification. COUNTY's Contractors have agreed in service agreement with the COUNTY to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend PURCHASER against all claims resulting from acts or omissions of COUNTY's Contractors.
- <u>Award of Contracts</u>. Final Contract awards are contingent upon COUNTY's transportation cost analysis. If the aggregate total revenue of the sorts does not equal or exceed the minimum total appraised value, some of the bids may be rejected.
