## Trash, Recycling, and Landfill Operation RFP February 23, 2024

It is the intent of the City of Derby to award the entire contract to one bidder.

The exhibits were omitted from the original RFP and are included in the addendum issued on 02-23-2024.

There is no requirement for bidders to provide a bid bond.

There is no limit to the number of barrels that a resident may place for collection.

There is no weight limit for trash barrels.

The annual tonnage for 2022-2023 is attached as part of addendum.

The City of Derby owns the compacter and scale at the Derby Transfer Station

The City of Derby provides recycling bins to residents, at no charge to the resident and at the City of Derby's cost.

The following items are unacceptable for Bulk pick up:

**Tires** 

**Propane Tanks** 

**Demolition and Construction Materials** 

**Appliances with Freon** 

Oils and Hazardous Fluids

The bid results from 2020 will be included in the addendum

The current City of Derby contract will be included as part of the addendum

There are 3 yard and 5-yard dumpsters at each of the Miscellaneous locations.

The residential pick-up schedule is included in the exhibits section.

The operator of the Transfer Station may charge commercial customers for accepting material at the Transfer Station. The City of Derby shall not incur any costs associated with Commercial usage of Transfer Station.
